SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES

2003 - 2004 Billing

- Forty-two accounts, including Canada, are being billed monthly for the 2003 2004 period.
- Nine of seventeen Caribbean countries have paid in full; one country is paying monthly.

Billing and Collection Solicitation

- The solicitation was released on January 30, 2004; NBANC submitted its bid on Friday, March 5, 2004.
- NBANC was one of two bids submitted.
- In early April, NBANC was advised by the FCC that Welch & Company, the Canadian accounting firm that serves as the Canadian numbering billing and collection agent, was awarded the five-year contract to be the NANPA B&C Agent, beginning July 1, 2004.

Transition Planning

 NBANC transition planning is geared toward having Welch and Co. perform the annual carrier billing for the 2004 – 2005 funding period to minimize carrier confusion related to the change in B&C Agent.

Request for Reimbursement

• The FCC OIG requested additional documentation in support of the NBANC October 2003 \$58Thousand request for reimbursement for additional work performed between October 2002 and December 2003. On March 30, NBANC met with the OIG, presenting a revised request for \$28Thousand along with the supporting documentation.
